According to the recent report from World Wildlife Foundation (WWF), plastic accounts for 95% of the total waste, found on coastlines and seabeds across the region. Translating this into numbers, the report claims that 570,000 tonnes of plastic were disposed in sea each year - the equivalent of 33,800 plastic bottles every minute. Even though many may rush to accuse the booming tourism as the number one factor exacerbating the situation, the real culprits of this non-point source pollution (pollutants released from numerous origins) situation can be found in the states of Italy, France, Turkey and Egypt. > However, merely the identification of the point source pollution (pollution release from a single, identifiable site) won't bring a ground-breaking change to the fate of the Mediterranean. It is essential to encourage action not only by the local communities, but also by local businesses and governments supervised by EU directives. An impact can be achieved by items, reducing the plastic producmanagement systems. However, unless the attention is given by both the EU and the local governments then the future of our sea might not seem so dark after all.

In addition, Norway was the first country to sign the Paris Agreement in November 2016, which is still taken as the first global agreement in the history of environmental issues. Its purpose, since 2016 is to reduce greenhouse gas emissions by 40% by the year 2030. Meanwhile in 2017, this country has reached the point where electricity generation is easily sustainable by having 96% of electricity generated by hydro power plants and of course having Fjords as a huge source. Norway has taxed almost 80% of the greenhouse gas emissions not even a europe-mapping-sources-fine-particulate-matter year later with the. The European Union and Norway are still in cooperation and are working on their project and aim for the 2030 goal.

Norway's most recent policies include the parliament that voted in June 2019 to extend divestment policies. They banned Fund investing for companies that have more than 10GW of electricity from coal. Norway has even set a goal for the year 2050 to reduce 90 to 95% greenhouse gas emissions.

Because of the country's attitude towards the problems and how effectively and actively, even after them being a major polluter, in the past they are solving it, they have become one of the safest countries dealing with environmental issues.

IT BOILS DOWN To Boilers

V icked witches gave boilers a bad name, but the Czech government moved to restrict them in 2019 for a different reason. Old-fashioned coal and wood powered household heaters were found responsible for over 95% of carcinogen airborne particles in city air.

The European Air Quality index ranks Prague below London, France and Berlin in terms of average air quality. Czech officials proposed a solution following a meeting with their EU colleagues. A stick and carrot plan is full steam ahead for September 2022. Boilers falling into the lowest two of five emission categories will be withdrawn and their owners compensated. They are already eligible for subsidies and interest-free loans to help replace the heat sources at minimal financial cost. In fact, it should even pay off. Heat Roadmap Europe, an EUfunded project, suggests a switch to district heating networks and thermal infrastructure would save money for 50-70% of European households. Alternatives to burning coal and wood end up cheaper. Until today, the problem for many was to muster the money for transition. This plan seeks to solve that.

Czech attempts fit the trend of increasing heating-source awareness. The case study of Britain stands out. A country known for its dependence on coal has managed to diversify and replace its heat energy source in a matter of just a few decades. Governments in the European west have been dealing with the issue effectively from the outset of the 21st century and their policies are now making their way to the rest of the continent.

Many Czechs criticize the perceived small scope of the new policy. Environmentalists living in a country sceptical of ecological policies celebrate it as a win regardless.

The idea of the obligatory math maturita was to increase the general level of mathematical knowledge in the nation, but as it is now, it will rather lead to a decreased chance of passing maturita, subsequently to a decreased chance of getting your desired job and if taken to an extreme, this could lead to an increase in the unsatisfied lowermiddle class population whose dreams could not be fulfilled due to one extra exam from a subject irrelevant to their career. Therefore, I believe that the only plausible solution is to cancel the allschools-mandatory maturita from mathematics altogether, and the necessity to have math classes in all types of secondary education schools with it.



This can sometimes have negative consequences, as ordinary users see the platform as an opportunity to hate on others, without being affected by it in their real life. This sense of anonymity brings more security, leading people to act this way.

What follows next is the creation of pressure. Again, this is not a matter of one side only. Followers can be very rude and are capable of putting a lot of pressure on influencers, who have to not only keep up with making entertaining content on their profile, as well as deal with all the negative comments the others leave. In reverse, I can prove that Instagram is a platform that can cause major anxiety and self-questioning, since the content we see isn't always the reality and often is far from it. Malcolm James McCormick was born on January the 19th 1992 in Pennsylvania and loved music since he was a kid. On January the 17th 2020 Mac's family put out his unreleased album 'Circles', saying that 'Malcolm was well into the process of recording his companion album to Swimming, entitled Circles. Two

> A day later, Kobe was travelling in his private helicopter with his daughter Gianna and 7 other people when suddenly the helicopter had engine complications and burst in flames. Nobody survived. The world lost a legend. Everyone was shocked and asking the same question. Why?

> Kobe was just 41 when he passed away. The internet was overwhelmed with condolences to Bryant's family. Celebrities hardly searched for words. Even the toughest men of basketball like Shaquille O'Neal (played for the Lakers with Kobe from 1996 to 2004, won three titles together) were crying. Even those who never cared about basketball knew who Kobe was. In every NBA game of the following round, players broke the 8 and 24-second violation rule to commemorate the two numbers that Kobe wore in LA Lakers. Both of these numbers are retired, so no Laker can wear them anymore.

> In his career, Kobe played 20 seasons for the Lakers, 10 of them with the number 8 and 10 with the number 24. He may be the only sportsman to have two retired numbers by one team. He won 5 NBA titles, 2 NBA finals MVP, 1 league MVP, 1 Slam Dunk contest and 2 gold Olympic medals. He had four daughters. After he retired, he trained his daughter Gianna's basketball team. Gianna was expected to be a very successful basketball player as her father was. Kobe also loved football, both American and soccer. He was a fan of his hometown NFL team Philadelphia Eagles and European football teams like FC Barcelona and AC Milan.
